New agri export policy to double farmer's income: Suresh Prabhu



Union Minister of Commerce & Industry and Civil Aviation, Suresh Prabhu said that the Government of India is preparing agro specific zones under the new Agriculture Export Policy which will be unveiled soon. India also has the added advantage of inheriting a tradition of organic farming. It is a great advantage for organic producers to tap the market which is growing steadily in both domestic and export markets. India ranks first in terms of total number of organic producers and 9th in terms of world's organic agricultural land. The Government of India has implemented the National Programme for Organic Production (NPOP) which is organised by the European Commission and United States Department of Agriculture (USDA).

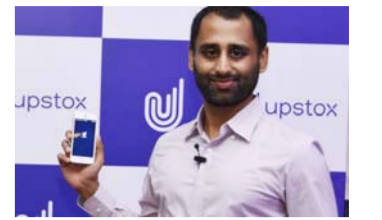

Five more rice mills cleared for exports to China

Five more rice mills have been cleared for exporting non-basmati rice, from India to China, taking the total to 24 rice mills. The first consignment of non-basmati rice, of 100 tonnes, was shipped to China, from Nagpur, in September this year.
In May this year, officials from China inspected rice mills that are capable of exporting non-basmati rice to China and 19 rice mills and processing units were registered for export to China.
During Prime Minister, Narendra Modi's, visit to China, in June this year, an MOU was signed between China's General Administration of Customs and India's Department of Agriculture on phytosanitary requirements for exporting rice from India to China. The 2006 protocol on phytosanitary requirements was amended to include the export of non-basmati varieties of rice from India.
China is the world's largest producer and importer of rice.
