

**Union Minister of Agriculture and Farmers' Welfare Radha Mohan Singh addresses National Conference of Fisheries Ministers of Coastal states**

During the last decade, India has attained first position with around 14% average annual growth in the export of fish & fishery products. Fish production in India has also grown by 27% in 2014-18 as compared to 2010-14. This was stated by the Union Minister of Agriculture and Farmers' Welfare Shri Radha Mohan Singh while addressing the Fisheries Ministers of Coastal states and Union Territories. Shri Singh further added that owing to low prospects of fisheries production along the coast, the government has decided to promote deep sea fishing and has introduced a sub-component 'Assistance for Deep Sea Fishing' under the Blue Revolution.

Shri Singh further said that under this scheme, self-help groups of traditional fishermen are being given 50 per cent of the vessel cost i.e. the central assistance of Rs 40 lakh for vessel costing up to Rs 80 lakh. Advanced and modern deep sea fishing vessels will be built in the country by indigenous technology. He informed that in the first year, central funds amounting to more than Rs 300 crore have been released for the implementation of this scheme benefitting fishermen from states like Tamil

Nadu, Andhra Pradesh and Gujarat.

Shri Singh also stated that the Government has made a budget provision of Rs 7,522.48 crore for the establishment of Fisheries and Aquaculture Infrastructure Development Fund (FAIDF) which has the potential to benefit 40 lakh marine and inland fishermen, especially women, self-help groups, weaker sections by making available modern infrastructure facilities and increased value of the produce. He said like farmers, fishermen will also get the benefit of 'Kisan Credit Card'. The Union Agriculture Minister expressed happiness that the new "National Policy on Marine Fisheries" was notified by the Ministry of Agriculture on May 1, 2017 after detailed discussions with stakeholders. This, he said, will promote the integrated development of marine fisheries in the country for the next 10 years. For an effective implementation of the policy, the Centre and the coastal states will have to work together. Shri Singh said according to estimates by scientists, existing marine fisheries' resources are over-exploited up to 200 meters depth from the mainland, thereby posing serious threat to the livelihood of traditional fishermen.

**Morepen Labs reports growth-filled fourth quarter**

**New Delhi,** Morepen Laboratories Ltd. has reported a 25 per cent rise in its consolidated net profit at Rs. 29.59 crore for the financial year 2017-18. The net profit in the previous financial year i.e. FY 2016-17 stood at Rs. 23.63 crore. The consolidated net sales revenue for the whole year stood at Rs. 598 crore registering a marginal increase of 1.9 per cent over previous year's sales of Rs. 586.41 crore.

During FY 2017-18, domestic sales were up by 21.3 per cent at Rs. 414 crore and export sales were down by 25 per cent at Rs. 183.66 crore. EBIDTA in FY 2017-18 increased by around 5 per cent at Rs. 68.45 crore, annual interest cost fell by 43

per cent at Rs. 4.36 crore and cash profit increased by around 11 per cent at Rs. 64.09 crore. The company aims to become a zero debt company by June-July 2018. Blood Pressure Monitors and Blood Glucose Monitors recorded highest growth on annual basis @ 75 percent and 38 percent respectively. The combined sales revenue of Blood Glucose Monitors and Blood Pressure Monitors in FY 2017-18 increased to Rs. 86.57 crore as compared to Rs. 59.26 crore in the previous fiscal, registering a growth of 46 per cent. The company has touched a base of two million installations of Glucometers in FY 2017-18 and sold 68 million strips during the year against 48 Millions of last year. (18-7)

**CAG and Secy MDWS empty toilet pit near Pune for Swachh Bharat**

The Comptroller and Auditor General of India, Shri Rajiv Mehrishi, and Secretary, Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation, Shri Parameswaran Iyer emptied a toilet pit from a twin pit toilet in rural Maharashtra early this morning. Senior sanitation officers from States across the country, including Additional Chief Secretaries of Maharashtra, Uttar Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, followed suit to encourage use of twin pit toilets in rural India, and to de-stigmatize emptying of toilet pits by the household themselves.

The twin-pit toilet is the safest toilet technology most suited to large parts of rural India and is recommended by the World Health Organization as well as the Government of India. Research has shown that one of the reasons rural households might hesitate in building and/or using this low-cost technology is the stigma associated with emptying of the pit.

However, it is scientifically proven that a pit in a standard twin-pit toilet model fills up in roughly 5 years for a 6-membered family. The waste can then be easily re-directed to the second pit, and it becomes safe-to-handle compost in 6 months to 1 year, and is rich in NPK (nitrogen, phosphorus, and potassium) nutrients which makes it ideal for use in agriculture. In many parts of India, this is also known as sonakhaad (golden fertilizer) because of high nutritious content.

Today's pit-cleaning exercise in Pandhwareddi

panchayat, Daund block of Pune district was a step towards dispelling these myths, biases and stigmas. Several State Principal Secretaries (Sanitation), senior officers of the Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin), and senior officers of Maharashtra government joined in this exercise.

All officers then held up the 40 compost jars full of the compost were taken home by all present at the event. The pit-emptying exercise was a part of an ODF-Sustainability workshop. The Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) has made significant progress in the three and a half years since its launch. The rural sanitation coverage has more than doubled since the launch of the mission from 39% to nearly 84%. Over 7 crore toilets have been built across rural India under the Mission. As an outcome, over 3.6 lakh villages and 385 districts have been declared Open Defecation Free (ODF), across 17 States and Union Territories. With over half the country declared ODF, the Mission is also working on sustaining the ODF status in these areas. To that end, detailed ODF Sustainability Guidelines have also been issued, and a workshop was conducted with ODF States and districts in Pune over the last two days.
