

Chewing Tobacco health risks connected with tobacco use

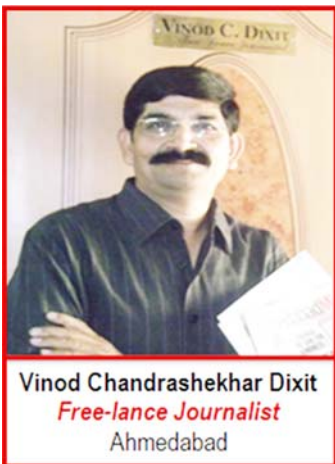


Irrespective of cultures and countries, backgrounds and ethnicities, tobacco is chewed in different forms and

ways. Tobacco use is the single most avoidable cause of death worldwide and is currently responsible for killing one in 10 adults worldwide. In India, at least 800,000 deaths every year are related to tobacco use, out of which 700,000 are related to smoking.. Chewing tobacco reduces the lunges to a sponge that soaks in at least 30 known carcinogens, or cancer causing chemicals. The list of tobacco

related diseases is long and includes heart and blood vessel diseases, bronchitis, asthma, impotence, birth

defects and growth retardation in babies, etc. Tobacco kills almost six million people each year and more than 600 000 are non-smokers breathing second-hand smoke. Tobacco causes cancer and most of us are aware that smoking causes lung cancer and chewing tobacco causes oral cancer. If a person wants to smoke, that is his own personal choice. However, the health effects that come with it affect nonsmokers, from the secondhand smoke to litter, and cause just as much damage to the people around them, something that cannot be ignored. Either way, smoking or chewing tobacco is not something that is welcome or a safe addiction.

Why is Circumcision Celebrated for Boys but Might be Ruled Illegal for Girls?

Male circumcision is nearly universal among Muslims and Jews throughout the world. For many parents, the decision to circumcise their male child is motivated by social and health benefits, including the suspected decrease in risk of urinary tract infections, sexually transmitted diseases, cancer, and even HIV, both in the male and his future sexual partners. And for many other parents, circumcision is a core tenant of their faith. In the Jewish tradition, circumcision is performed on the eighth day after the birth of the male child, marking the entrance into Abraham's covenant with God: "You shall be circumcised in the flesh of your foreskins, and it shall be a sign of the covenant between me and you" (Genesis 17:11). And in the Islamic tradition, circumcision honors Muslims' Abrahamic roots as descendants of Abraham's first-born son Ismael, with the procedure

referenced in a number of jurisprudential books. In India, male circumcision is legal, and it makes no difference whether it's simply a routine procedure habitually requested by families before the male child leaves the hospital or an important part of their religious faith. However, the Supreme Court is currently considering the Attorney General's view that a similar and largely symbolic ceremony for girls should be made illegal. This view is opposed by the vast majority of women from the Dawoodi Bohra faith, a Shia Muslim denomination that believes boys and girls should participate in Abraham's covenant. In the Bohra tradition, male children are circumcised while female children participate in a form of female circumcision that is similar in terms of the symbolism and yet, in reality, is considerably less invasive and ultimately harmless.-

Reusable Launch Vehicle

On May 23, 2016, India became the fifth nation to successfully conduct the flight demonstration of a scaled down version of a winged-body reusable launch vehicle, thereby validating the critical technologies such as autonomous navigation, guidance & control, reusable thermal protection system and re-entry mission management. This flight represented the first baby step towards the realisation of a future fully reusable Two Stage To Orbit (TSTO) space transportation system.

A fully reusable Two Stage To Orbit (TSTO) Launch Vehicle, that can launch payloads to Low Earth Orbit with 15 times reusability, is expected to reduce the launch cost by approximately 50 - 60% when compared to that of an expendable launch vehicle.

This information was

provided by the Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) Development of North-Eastern Region (DoNER), MoS PMO, Personnel, Public Grievances & Pensions, Atomic Energy and Space, Dr.Jitendra Singh in written reply to a question in Rajya Sabha today.
